Once you get off the plane, follow the signs to Immigration.

Use the blue lane marked visa.

Carry your Passport, I-20 and evidence of payment for your SEVIS application in your hand luggage.

Failure to have the right documents can result in delays or possible denial of entry into the US.

The immigration officer may take your fingerprints and ask you questions about your reasons for studying in the US.

After passport control, follow signs to the baggage reclaim area.

Check the information screens to find the correct carousel, collect your baggage and make your way to Customs.

To avoid complications, do not bring more than \$250 in cash on arrival.

Otherwise, make a declaration at Customs.

If you have arranged for a taxi, find your driver waiting in the Arrivals area.

Look out for a person holding a placard with your name and the CATS Academy logo.

Cannot find your driver? STAY at the information booth. Ask the official to help you contact your driver.
